In this role, the incumbent will:

- Manage the activities the materials department to include customer service, inventory control, supply chain management, scheduling, and shipping/receiving.
- Uphold and maintain team culture, providing a safe, healthy and positive work environment.
- Supervise, motivate, evaluate, engage, and develop staff to reach goals and document inventory transactions.
- Adhere to established safety and quality systems policies, procedures and practices.
- Support the organization's efforts toward continuous improvement as well as CVG's goals and core values.
- Demonstrate teamwork by collaborating with others to improve overall standards of performance and service.
- Problem solve any issues specific to shipping and receiving; reduce obsolescence and waste of materials.
- Continuously improve customer service (both internal and external), with a goal of 100% on-time delivery.
- Participate on special teams and complete additional tasks as assigned.
- Ensure vendor forecasts and releases are issued.
- Expedite receipt of production materials and assist in expediting all other materials.
- Notify receiving of scheduled part deliveries if parts are expedited.
- Monitor Supplier delivery performance and issue corrective actions as needed.
- Manage supply chain and collaborate with Suppliers to minimize production disruptions.
- Collaborate with manufacturing team and advise of potential parts shortages.
- Follow IATF procedures regarding materials substitutions, deviations, and engineering changes.
- Develop and maintain a cycle count program. Schedule cycle counts and complete analysis. Monitor schedules, maintain cutoff dates for cycle adjustments and month end close.
- Troubleshoot incorrect counts and adjust; key entries to maintain accurate inventory counts.
- Maintain physical inventory with a variance of 1.5% or less.
- Partner with Accounting to ensure balance between book and perpetual inventory counts.
- Interact with Engineering in maintenance of engineering change coordination.
- Run Month End reports and make adjustments.
- Responsible for keeping inventory turns and maintain costs at established goals.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree and/or 5-7 years' directly related experience including experience in providing departmental leadership to direct reports; CPIM certificate preferred.
- Excellent written and verbal/interpersonal communication skills; able to effectively communicate across multiple levels of the organization including senior management.



- Must have high level organizational skills, attention to detail, and ability to apply problem solving techniques.
- Team player able to work well in groups, as well as individually contribute in a fast pace growth environment.
- Experienced in use of Baan, Microsoft Dynamics 365, or other MRP systems.
- Fluent with MS Office 2013 including advanced Excel skills.
- Lean Six Sigma training and experience is a plus.
